Learning Journey - Geography, DT (cooking and nutrition) and Science.

This term the children will be answering the question, 'Why would you choose Lincolnshire to build your farm?' In Geography, we will be using maps to locate cities and counties in the UK with a key focus on Lincolnshire. We will be creating a survey for our visit to Rand Farm Park, using human and physical geographical features, to help us identify why Lincolnshire if a good place to farm. In DT, we will be looking at foods that are produced and grown in Lincolnshire and sample a selection of these foods with a focus on what constitutes a healthy balance diet. We will also be developing the skills of peeling, cutting and mashing in order to create a sausage and mash meal. In Science, we will be investigating different types of rocks and soils to understand why Lincolnshire is so good for farming.
