



How many days of education were missed last term due to holidays taken during term time?

Last term, 5th September to 20th October 2023,

50 days were lost due to holidays taken during term time. This resulted in 3 FPN's being issued.

Requests for holidays during term time will be unauthorised, unless under exceptional circumstances, and a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN) may be issued. The Fixed Penalty Notice is £60 or £120 per parent, per child. If repeated holidays are taken during term time, the Local Authority will be informed and further action may be taken.

There are 365 days in a calendar year. 190 of these are schools days, the other 175 days can be used for shopping, holidays and appointments (where possible)
