


# **Key Instant Recall Facts (KIRFs)**

## Year 1 Autumn Term 1

## I can read and write numbers 1-10, at least, in numerals

This term's KIRF is to be able to correctly form digits 0-9, read numerals to at least 10 and write numerals to at least 10. E.g. Write the number 8. What number is this: 9? Below are the correct formation for numerals 0-9. Start at the red dot and follow the arrow.



### **Top Tips**

The secret to success is practising little and often.

Use time wisely. Practise on the way to school or during a journey.

Look out for numerals in the environment for children to read.

## **Questions to Ask**

What number can you see on that house?
What number is that bus?
Can you find the number 4 in this book?

Practise writing numerals in the air, in sand, using chalk. Go on a number hunt in your local area or around your house.
